

Did you know you can get routine vaccines at the pharmacy?



Visiting your local pharmacy is a convenient and efficient way of staying up to date with your vaccinations!

Depending on the vaccine, it may be fully covered by your insurance. Please check with Capital Rx by calling the number on the back of your ID card to confirm your coverage and responsibility.

Examples of vaccines available:

- COVID-19*
- Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B*
- Human papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (flu)*
- Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR)

- Meningococcal (meningitis)
- Pneumococcal (pneumonia)
- Polio
- Typhoid[^]
- Zoster (shingles)*
- Varicella (chicken pox)
